# Closing Message

Our adventure began on February 3, 2009, 28 students, 1 teacher aide, 1 teacher, a new classroom, and an in-store promotional banner took on the task of completing Kagman High School's first year book in three years. 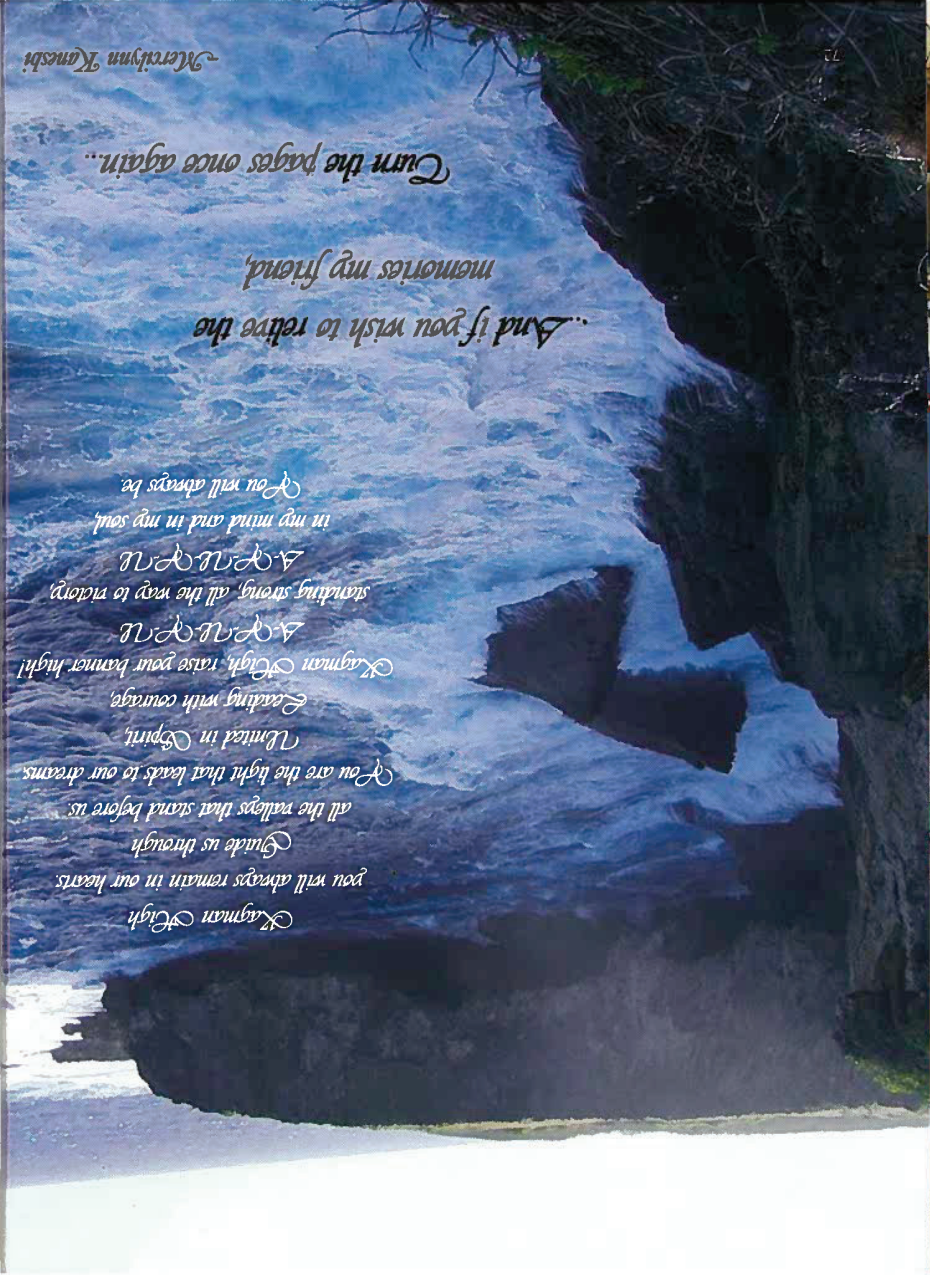
