~ Bouncing Back

The 2016-2017 School year was a year for KHS to bounce back from the hardships of the previous year marked by Typhoon Souldelor. Our campus losses were slowly restored on behalf of FEMA recovery funding. It was slow because the whole island was recovering at the same time; so materials and resources were scarce and projects took more time to complete. On a positive note, all PSS schools' local budget allocations were doubled, so there were many facility improvements that we were able to complete such as: re-tiling the Library, installation of security cameras, installation of 8 Meraki internet access points, installation of solar exterior lights and interior upgrades from fluorescent lighting to LED lighting to name a few.



~ College and Career Readiness

Our first batch of Million Dollar \$cholars (Class of 2016) made it to their respective universities and settled in for their first year of college abroad. Meanwhile here at home, we began the next steps of grooming the next set of Kagman High Million Dollar \$cholars from this years graduating class. Our MD\$ visionary, Mr G vanGils, won CNMI Statewide Teacher of the Year honors because of his hard work to ensure KHS students break past the barriers that typically keep a student from pursuing higher education abroad. Now we are scaling up, starting a Juniors College Prep class in the Spring to help students prepare for the next MD\$ cohort. We also started a freshman PSAT prep cohort, who will continue to be groomed for MD\$ greatness. This years MD\$ cohort will be attending the following colleges: Aurora Community College in Colorado, Dixie State University in Utah, Eastern Oregon University, Hollins University in Virginia, Northern Marianas College, Plymouth State University in New Hampshire, San Diego Mesa College in California, University of Guam, Washington Seattle Community College and Wenatchee Valley College in Washington.




~ What is a reading Lexile? The Lexile Framework for Reading is a scientific approach to measuring reading ability. The Lexile Framework is a scale for measuring the reading ability of a student. The Lexile Framework can also measure the complexity of reading materials. The Lexile scale is like a thermometer, except rather than measuring temperature, the Lexile Framework measures a text's complexity and a reader's skill level. 
At KHS, we focused on raising student Lexile scores because Lexiles also measure reading comprehension. Reading comprehension is a critical skill all students must master to be college and career ready. This is KHS' ultimate desired outcome. We are proud to announce that even before the post test was completed, we obliterated that goal with student growth at 55 Lexile points on average! 63% of all KHS students raised their reading lexile by 25 points or higher by the submission of this report. The highest growth reported by a student was an astonishing 420 points! All of this was possible because of the hard work and dedication of all KHS teachers and staff. ALL KHS teachers, with the exception of math teachers, used the Achieve 3000 reading program to support literacy and lexile growth across campus.
