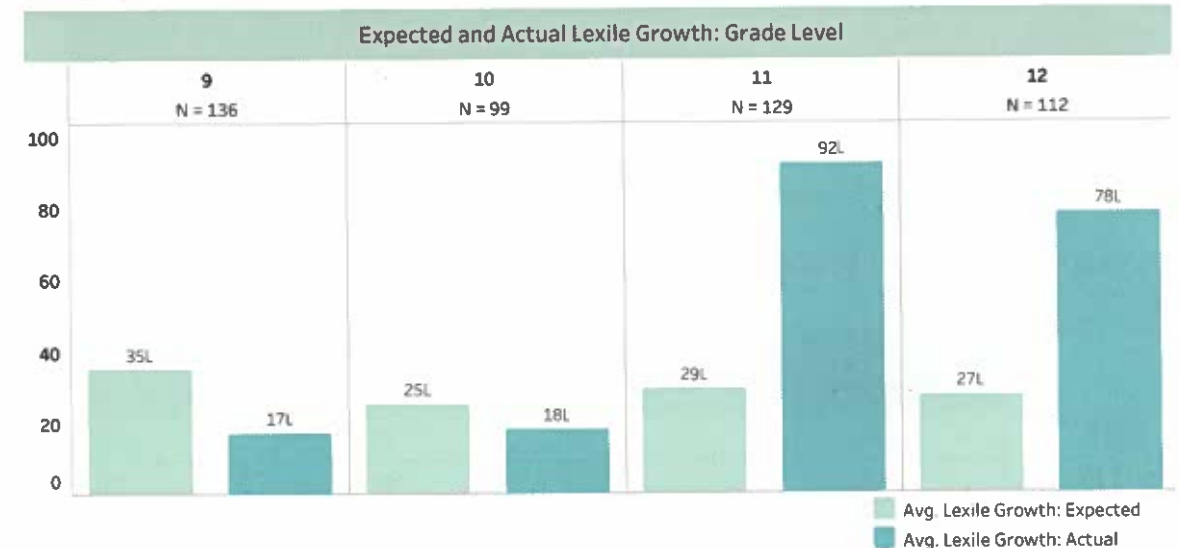

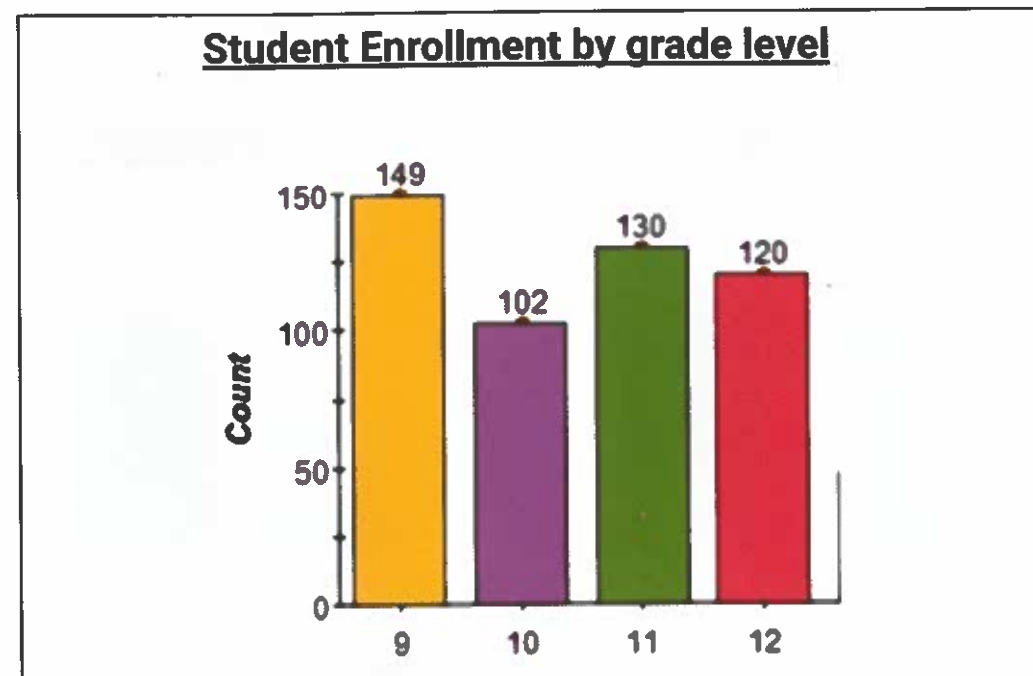

These graphs display student data on Achieve 3000. Despite the effects of the pandemic, KHS was able to recover some learning loss through lexile points. As you can see, KHS surpassed the "expected" growth.



This chart simply displays the enrollment population for KHS as of SY 20-21'.

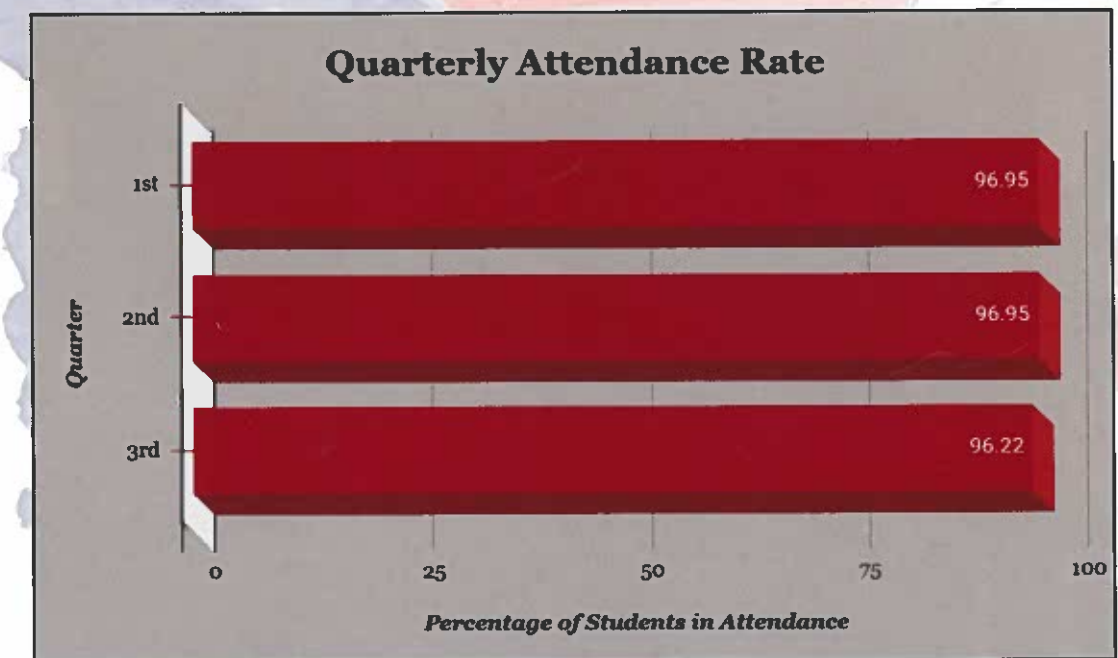

These charts reflect our STAR assessments as of 3rd Quarter. Again, this data is a reflection of how learning loss is evident from the effects of the pandemic. The loss of instructional time and the adaptation of a new mode of learning has been detrimental to our goals.



This chart reflects the attendance rate. Despite the pandemic, KHS was able to achieve an average of 96% attendance rate for the first three quarters. However, not shown on this chart is the amount of students who were reported to SARC and successfully made it back to campus after the meetings.

In SY 20-21', KHS conducted approximately 20 home visits for truancy and as a result, approximately 80% of the home visits were successful. The other 20% were referred to SARC (Student Attendance Report Committee).

# MATH COHORT

## Founding of the Program

The Cohort Program began in December 2016 when Coach Wessel consulted with then Principal, Mrs. Leila Staffler, on offering PSAT preparation to students in their freshman and sophomore year. Today, the program is indebted to and continues to rely on Ms. Elle Rayphand-Sablan, Kagman High School's excellent Freshman Algebra I teacher, who annually chooses students that she feels have demonstrated resilience, perseverance, high academic effort, willingness to learn new math material and work with others to learn, along with an interest in the Cohort program itself. Without her, the Cohort program flops.

This Cohort program initially fed directly into the Million Dollar Scholar Program. Guest speakers came to share their wealth of experience with all the Cohort students as well, such as Dave Burger, a local Certified Public Accountant in Saipan; Aziz Sabeti, a student at the University of Guam; Mark Durand, a doctor; Kim Sabeti, a small business owner in Guam; and Maria Ornes, an alumna at Stanford University and Kagman High's very own librarian. In the years to come, former Cohort students will be guest speakers and share their journey with the Cohort program and of college and beyond!



## Honorable Mentions

Mr. Loremel Hocog, last year, took over the advanced English duties for the Cohort program. Thus, all cohorts, excluding Cohort #1, have taken an advanced English class during their Sophomore year. Hocog continues to teach AP Language and Composition to the Cohort students during the junior year. Beginning this year, Mr. Dominic Pangelinan is teaching Honors English in 10th grade for all of the following Cohorts.

Mr. Kyle Mateo began by taking Cohort #1 students during their HQ classes. Mr. David Bucher then took over the HQ the next year with Cohort #2 students. For the next batch, Ms. Jocelyn Itibus co-taught HQ with Coach Wessel for a couple of months until she officially took over in the spring of 2020 before the pandemic hit.

## Laudable Feats

In the spring of 2017, KHS decided to offer the first batch of selected students (Cohort #1) both Honors Geometry and Algebra 2 during their sophomore year in order to better prepare them for the math portions in the PSAT and SAT tests, which generally contain algebra 2 and geometry questions.

The first 2-Day campus Visit to UOG took place in April 2018, where seven Cohort #1 students flew to Guam to enjoy being treated like college prospects. They visited classrooms, mingled with professors, participated in science chemistry experiments, consulted with college students in an actual Sociology class with Dr. Kirk Johnson, and sat down with college math students. Cohort #1 graduated last year (May 2020) and are off to many different universities and colleges, including the military.

Cohort #2 started during HQ 4th quarter where 27 students became a part of Cohort #2, 15 of whom flew to Guam for the 2nd Annual UOG 2-Day campus Visit in April 2019. Cohort #2 are graduating this year (May 2021) and are going to many different colleges, including the United States Military Academies.

Cohort #3 was the largest Cohort class so far with 36 students! The year was unfortunately cut short due to the pandemic, but they continued with the Cohort program as juniors this year with precalculus with Mr. Camacho. Camacho taught precalculus and calculus to Cohorts #1 and #2 over the past few years. Additionally, this batch of students started the annual NMC 1-Day campus visit program.

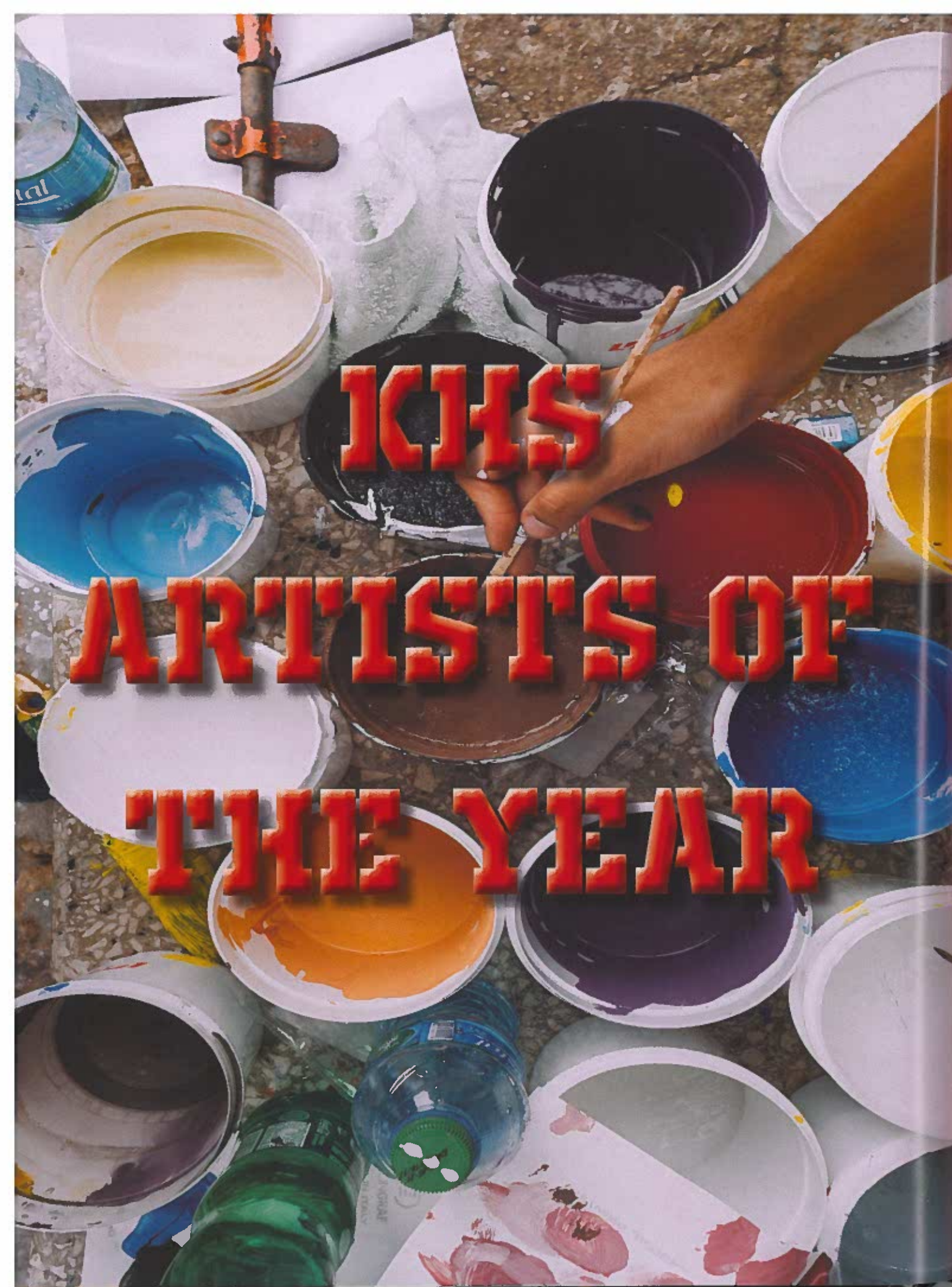
Cohort #4 is a group of 27 students. This will be the first group who will take Coach Wessel for both Honors Geometry and Algebra 2 their sophomore year (2020-2021), along with precalculus for the first time next school year. They also have the option to take calculus with Mr. Ryan Camacho during their senior year. Cohort #4 students also started the annual Tennis Clinic with Hall of Fame Coach Jeff Race.

## Summary of Accomplishments

The Cohort program is producing many students who are not only achieving higher scores in the PSAT (the highest score to date is in the 1300's out of 1520), but are also testing into the Northern Marianas College's math courses, MA132 and MA164. But perhaps even more commendable is the fact that the program is establishing an environment that promotes active learning and encourages rapport among students.
